1. CALL TO ORDER: 5:05 p.m.

2. ROLL CALL/PLEDGE OF ALLEGIANCE:

Commissioners Present – Commissioners Khan, Hook, and Chair Parilla

Commissioners Absent – DaCosta and Flores

Staff Members Present – City Manager Nissen, Deputy Engineer Indrawan, Engineer Castaneda, Assistant Police Chief Forbes, Deputy Myers, Fire Chief Scribner, Traffic Engineer Gibbons, and Recording Secretary Wuence.

The Pledge of Allegiance was presented by Chair Parilla.

3. PUBLIC COMMENT:

Dale Wrathall, resident, shared his concerns regarding traffic issues around Eastvale Elementary. He believes more law enforcement is needed, especially at the intersection of Scholar Way and Orange.

Cindy Quach, resident, shared concerns regarding criminal activity in her neighborhood such as, speeding, loitering, vandalism, and theft.

4. PRESENTATIONS:

4.1 Monthly Police Department Update

Lieutenant Forbes provided the staff report for this item.

He provided a summary of calls for service, traffic statistics for the month, including collisions and citations, and vehicle burglaries for the period.

He discussed the arrest and booking of a suspect on several counts of sexual battery and the ongoing investigation.

Chair Parilla inquired about response time for vehicle and home burglary calls. Lt. Forbes reviewed the levels of calls received and average response time for each call type.

There was discussion regarding coverage in Eastvale when adjacent cities require assistance.

4.2 **Monthly Fire Department Update**

Chief Scribner reviewed calls for service for the period and average response times. He discussed recent deployment of staff to the Northern California fires. He reviewed National Night Out participation. He noted that the Medic Squad would be in service soon. He discussed a recent Hazardous Materials call at the PetSmart and noted that no Hazardous Materials were found.

4.3 **Update on Neighborhood Watch and Crime Prevention**

Community Relations Officer Myers noted that there has been increased interest in Neighborhood Watch and she has several presentations coming up.

4.4 **Introduction of Public Works Staff Member**

Deputy Engineer Indrawan introduced traffic engineer Ramon Gibbons and reviewed his responsibilities.

6.1 **Sidewalk Repairs at Various Locations –**

Deputy Engineer Indrawan provided a PowerPoint presentation for the item.

He reviewed three locations for upcoming sidewalk repairs and summarized the bid process and timeline for those projects.

6.2 **Truck Route Study Update**

Recommendation: Receive verbal update.

Deputy Engineer Indrawan presented the staff report for this item. He noted that developers have been notified of their required participation in a truck route study. He noted that they have responded favorably and funds are expected soon from one developer. Consultants are being interviewed for assistance with determining fee amounts to be assessed for the truck route study.

7. ***FUTURE AGENDA ITEMS:***

Commissioner Khan initiated discussion regarding the concerns of resident Quach. It was noted that Police is working with her on the issues. City Manager Nissen discussed police coverage and collaboration with other entities for future large scale events in and around the City.

Commissioner Parilla initiated discussion regarding special event permits and cost recovery. City Manager Nissen reviewed the informal process in place to advise and meet with City departments for special events. She noted that other agencies must submit a traffic control plan if the event would impact the public right of way, which is reviewed by Public Works, Fire, and Police. She noted that outside agencies hosting events are directly billed for any police costs.

8. ***CITY STAFF REPORT:***

City Manager Nissen thanked the Commissioners for their participation in National Night Out. She noted that the event was a success and shared some of the compliments received by the other cities that participated in the event.

She requested a Commission representative attend the upcoming City Council Meeting to provide an update to Council. She invited the Commissioners to attend the September 11 Memorial Event at Fire Station 27 at 6:30 a.m. She noted that the CERT class would also begin on September 11.

Deputy Engineer Indrawan congratulated City Manager Nissen on the completion of her MPA.

Deputy Engineer Indrawan provided an update on the status of the traffic signal at 65th and Sumner, noting that construction would possibly begin in Spring 2016.

9. ***COMMISSION COMMUNICATIONS:***

Commissioner Hook noted that he could not attend the latest School Board Meeting and requested an update. Deputy City Engineer Indrawan provided an update from the meeting.

City Manager Nissen noted that International Walk to School Day was on October 7, 2015. She noted that financial support from City Council would be requested as the Riverside Coalition did not receive grant funds for raffle prizes and gifts for children participating.

There being no further business, the meeting was adjourned at 6:02 p.m.





Residential Projects Under Construction:

- Location: South side of Citrus Street between Scholar Way at Sumner Ave
 - Public Improvement 90% complete
 - Homes under construction
 - Few phases are occupied
 - “No-Right Turn, 7-9am” symbol signs were added for eastbound Citrus Street traffic at Granja Vista Del Rio/ H.S. Driveway beginning May 6, 2015.

Tract 34014 – DR Horton (Eastvale Project # 13-0395)

- Location: Southeast corner of Schleisman Road at Scholar Way
 - Public Improvement 90% complete
 - Homes under construction
 - Few phases are occupied
 - Schleisman Rd was opened on March 29th for traffic.

 - School opened on July 6, 2015
 - Traffic is being monitored for improvement recommendations
 - Met with school principal and school district traffic investigator to review and discuss traffic circulation around the school. Traffic Counts were conducted and analysis is currently being conducted to evaluate school crossings for possible safety enhancements
