CIRCLE CITY SUBSTATION 66 KV SUB-TRANSMISSION LINE PROJECT

The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) is currently processing an application by Southern California Edison (SCE) to construct new overhead electrical transmission lines through residential neighborhoods in Eastvale. The City is on record opposing the project and suggesting that the lines be buried to reduce impacts to our quality of life.

The CPUC will soon be circulating a Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) that identifies the environmental impacts of the project. The City and public will have a chance to review and comment on the Draft EIR. The CPUC will ultimately hold public hearings on the project, when the City and residents will be able to attend and comment directly to CPUC decision-makers.

The City is hosting this meeting to bring Eastvale residents together with SCE representatives to learn more about the project. This is an opportunity to get information directly from SCE staff about the proposed electrical transmission lines.

City staff will make a presentation on next steps in the process, including when comments can be sent to the CPUC.
