5.1 Budget for the Possible Formation of an Eastvale Police Department and a Ballot Measure to Enhance General Fund Revenues

He also requested clarification on how the Community Satisfaction Study was conducted. City Manager Jones confirmed it was two separate items and that it was done through a mixed methodology. Vice-Chair Dinco stated that he had received the Draft Feasibility Study the night before and didn't have time to adequately review it and would like to have workshops to allow public engagement.
