1. CALL TO ORDER

5. COMMISSION BUSINESS ITEMS

5.1 All-Way Stop at Sumner Avenue and 68th Street

Public Works contract Engineer Hemsley summarized the staff report and responded to Public Safety Commission inquires.

Chair Dinco opened the public comment portion of the item. Hearing no response, Chair Dinco closed the public comment portion of the item.

On motion of Chair Dinco and second by Vice-Chair Gracia, the Public Safety Commission reviewed the All-Way Stop at Sumner Avenue and 68th Street and recommended that City Council approve the proposed signs.

5.2 Safe Route to School and Pedestrian Safety Improvements on 68th Street from Wells Spring Road to I-15 Bridge

Public Works contract Engineer Hemsley summarized the staff report and responded to Public Safety Commission inquires.

Chair Dinco opened the public comment portion of the item. Hearing no response, Chair Dinco closed the public comment portion of the item.

On motion of Vice-Chair Gracia and second by Commissioner Varela, the Public Safety Commission reviewed the proposed route to school and pedestrian safety

improvements on 68th Street from Wells Spring Road to I-15 bridge and recommended that City Council approve as proposed.

5.3 Eleanor Roosevelt High School Neighborhood Traffic Concerns Along Citrus Avenue (Estancia Community/Desi Lane)

Public Works contract Engineer Hemsley summarized the staff report and responded to Public Safety Commission inquires.

Chair Dinco opened the public comment period.

Felicia Chen, Eastvale Public Library Branch Manager, wanted to assure that the changes weren't going to impact the library parking.

With no one else desiring to speak on this item, Chair Dinco closed the public comment period.

On motion of Commissioner Fitch and second by Vice-Chair Gracia, the Public Safety Commission:

1. Recommended that Council authorize staff to make modifications to the intersection of Citrus Street and Granja Vista Del Rio/ERHS parking lot to either significantly reduce the northbound through movements from Granja Vista Del Rio into ERHS parking lot or only allow left or right turns onto Citrus Street from 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. Staff will then implement an increase to the Citrus Street eastbound left-turn movement time to allow 40-50 cars to make the turning movement per cycle during the 7:00 a.m. – 8:00 a.m. time period. As a result, additional green time can be given to the eastbound left turn movement.
2. Recommended that Council authorize staff to remove the pedestrian cross walk, following a public notice and hearing, on the west side of the intersection of Citrus Street and Granja Vista Del Rio/ERHS parking lot. This would only have pedestrians crossing Citrus Street on the east side of the signalized intersection to prevent conflicting movements with the overlapping eastbound left-turning movement and the southbound right-turning movements.

Chair Dinco opened the public comment portion of the meeting. Hearing no response, Chair Dinco closed the public comment portion of the meeting.

7. CITY STAFF REPORT

City Manager Jones provided an update on upcoming City events.
