Summary

The City of Eastvale called for a General Municipal Election on November 6, 2018, for filling three (3) City Council seats in District 1, District 3, and District 4. The District 1 election was cancelled on August 21, 2018, due to the incumbent being the only candidate to file nomination papers as of the close of the nomination period.

The actual cost of the election will be determined upon receipt of the final invoice from the County of Riverside Registrar of Voters (ROV). A budget allocation of \$78,000 was made in the current budget year for the election based upon an initial estimate received from the ROV.

Background

The City of Eastvale held its General Municipal Election on November 6, 2018, for the purposes of filling two (2) full-term City Council member seats. For all purposes, the election was conducted in accordance with the Elections Code of the State of California. In addition to reciting facts related to the canvass of returns and certification of results, the attached resolution formalizes the process of declaring the results of the election pursuant to Elections Code Section 10263, 10264 and 10265.

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It is therefore recommended that the City Council adopt the above-referenced resolution, direct the City Clerk to administer the Oath of Office to the newly-elected City Council members, and present the Certificates of Election.

The accompanying resolution and Exhibit A identify the results of the balloting. By adopting the resolution, the City Council declares elected the following individuals:

- Jocelyn Yow, District 4 (Full Term/4 years)

WHEREAS, a General Municipal Election was held and conducted in the City of Eastvale, California, on Tuesday, November 6, 2018, as required by law; and

WHEREAS, notice of the election was given in time, form and manner as provided by law; that voting precincts were properly established; that election officers were appointed and that in all respects the election was held and conducted and the votes were cast, received and canvassed and the returns made and declared in time, form and manner as required by the provisions of the Elections Code of the State of California for the holding of elections in general law cities; and

WHEREAS, the County Registrar of Voters canvassed the returns of the elections and has certified the results to this City Council, the results are received, attached, and made a part hereof as “Exhibit A.”

**NOW, THEREFORE, THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF EASTVALE,
CALIFORNIA, DOES RESOLVE, DECLARE, DETERMINE AND ORDER AS FOLLOWS:**

Section 1. That the whole number of ballots cast in the City, including vote by mail ballots and provisional ballots was a total of 6,480.

Section 4. The City Council does declare and determine that Clint Lorimore (full term) and Jocelyn Yow (full term) were elected Members of the City Council.

Section 5. The City Clerk shall enter on the records of the City Council of the City, a statement of the result of the election, showing: (1) The whole number of ballots cast in the City; (2) The names of the persons voted for; (3) For what office each person was voted for; (4) The number of votes given at each precinct to each person; (5) The total number of votes given to each person.

Section 6. That the City Clerk shall immediately make and deliver to each person so elected a Certificate of Election signed by the City Clerk and authenticated; that the City Clerk shall also administer to each person elected the Oath of Office prescribed in the Constitution of the State of California and shall have them subscribed to it and file it in the Office of the City Clerk. Each and all of the persons so elected shall then be inducted into the respective office to which they have been elected.

Section 7. That the City Clerk shall certify to the passage and adoption of this resolution and enter it into the book of original resolutions.

Background

The City Council routinely creates and appoints two-member ad hoc subcommittees to further study topics of limited scope and duration to advise the City Council as a whole, or the City Manager.

An ad hoc, advisory committee composed solely of less than a quorum of a legislative body is exempt from the Brown Act, if the advisory serves a limited or single purpose, and are not perpetual, and are to be dissolved once their specific task is completed. Standing committees are subcommittees with either a continuing subject matter jurisdiction and/or a set meeting schedule, or are committees consisting of members from multiple legislative bodies.

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Staff recommends that the City Council review the current list of the City Council subcommittees and reappoint/appoint as necessary. The City Council may also decide to dissolve any committee that is no longer needed.
