EASTVALE, CA – Out of an abundance of caution and as the circumstances around the Coronavirus continues to rapidly evolve, we have now received recommendation from our public safety professionals to physically close our doors to City Hall starting noon on March 16, 2020, until further notice.

City staff will still be available electronically to provide services to the residents and businesses in the community. The closure is a result of our front counter space not having adequate room to create physical distance.
