Current COVID-19 Numbers

as of Tuesday, September 8

- ✓ Confirmed Tests in Riverside County – 556,173
- ✓ Confirmed Cases in Riverside County – 54,735
- ✓ Confirmed Deaths in Riverside County – 1,085
- ✓ Confirmed Recoveries in Riverside County – 48,761
- ✓ Confirmed Cases in Eastvale - 997
- ✓ Confirmed Recoveries in Eastvale - 897
- ✓ Confirmed Deaths in Eastvale – 17

Governor issues new Guidelines

- ✓ Effective August 31st, a color-coded tiered system was released.
- ✓ Hair salons and barber shops could open on August 31st.

WIDESPREAD Most non-essential indoor business operations are closed.	More than 7 Daily new cases (per 100k)	More than 8% Positive tests
SUBSTANTIAL Some non-essential indoor business operations are closed.	4-7 Daily new cases (per 100k)	5-8% Positive tests
MODERATE Some business operations are open with modifications.	1-3.9 Daily new cases (per 100k)	2-4.9% Positive tests
MINIMAL Most business operations are open with modifications.	Less than 1 Daily new cases (per 100k)	Less than 2% Positive tests

- ✓ City staff hosted a free mask giveaway at City Hall on September 1st. The masks were donated from Riverside County as part of their “Masks are Medicine” campaign.



Eastvale BizSupport/ Outdoor Dining Permits

- ✓ City staff established the “Eastvale BizSupport” program to provide resources to businesses affected by COVID-19.
- ✓ Staff is also providing outdoor dining permits at no cost to businesses, with a 24-48 hour turnaround for permit approval.
